HALLS AFC

Formed in 1919, the original J&E Hall FC were a local league success from the early years, dominating the amateur leagues and cups. As a well known name in local football, Halls FC was the newly shortened and adopted name by the 1970s.

After the Millenium, Veterans football was created, and then Mini-Soccer and Youth teams. After promotion in 2022 to the Premier Division of the Kent County League, the First Team were crowned Champions in April 2024 and await promotion to Step 6; the highest position it has ever been.

Alongside the First Team, a Saturday Reserves and two Sunday League teams complete plus Junior teams from Under 4s to Under 16s.

The Club is now 105 years old


